Sculpin - Ballast Point, San Diego, CA

India Pale Ale, 7.0% ABV

Created by two guys in the back of their home brew store, Sculpin brews hops with a hint of apricot, peach, mango, and lemon flavors. Sculpin is a gold medal winning IPA. \$6.00

Mass Rising - Jack's Abby, Framingham, MA

Double India Pale Pilsner, 8.0% ABV

In just 3 short years, Jack's Abby has redefined the lager category many times. Mass Rising is saturated with hoppiness from the kettle, hopback, and dry hopping stages. Light bitterness, super smooth body, and utterly drinkable. Rated # 3 in best American doubles in the world. \$7.00

Sophie - Goose Island Beer Co., Chicago, IL

Belgian Style Farmhouse Ale, 6.5% ABV

Farmhouse ales, also called saisons, convey tart, dry and fruity flavors. A very light beer, first brewed as a hydrating beer, it boasts citrus and peppery notes. A smooth vanilla finish rounds out this outstanding beer. \$6.50

Plum Island Belgian White - Newburyport Brewing Co., Newburyport, MA - Witbier, 5.4% ABV

Orange and coriander flavors mix beautifully with unfiltered yeast to satisfy any lover of the witbier style. This mellow beer will remind you of warmer temperatures. \$6.00

Stella Artois - Belgium

Pilsner, 5.2% ABV, \$6.25

Dry Irish Stout, 4.20% ABV

Long Thaw - Harpoon Brewery, Windsor, VT

White IPA, 6.2% ABV

A combination between an American IPA and a Belgian Witbier. This solid offering from Harpoon brings together the mellow taste of a wit and the citrus impressions of an IPA. It will interest those who want a softer and more refreshing version of the American IPA. \$5.25

Duara - Estrella Damm S. A., Barcelona, Spain

Euro Pale Lager, 5.4% ABV

Light and crisp, everything a good lager should be. Saaz Hops, which belong to the noble family of hops, convey an earthy flowery taste. *Gluten-Free beer drinkers should know that this beer was made with malted barley. The gluten was then removed by a special process lending it to 3 parts per million. \$6.00

Rich and Dan's Rye IPA - Harpoon Brewery, Windsor, VT - Rye India Pale Ale, 6.9% ABV

Subtle citrus and spice flavors add character to this beer, making it more than just your old standby Harpoon IPA. \$6.00

Cold Snap - The Boston Beer Co., Boston, MA

Witbier, 5.3% ABV

Traditional Belgian Witbiers are often spiced with orange peel and coriander. Sam Adams adds a fun twist to this recipe by adding plum, lemon, tamarind, anise, and hibiscus. This beer is very smooth at 7 IBUs. \$5.75

Rebel - Sam Adams Brewing Co., Boston, MA

American India Pale Ale, 6.5% ABV

Finally Sam Adams has created a beer in the west coast IPA category. This style encompasses a range of citrus-floral flavors with a light malt backbone. A very smooth and hoppy IPA which might just become your new favorite Sam Adams beer. \$6.25

Milk Stout Nitro - Left Hand, Longmont, CO

Sweet Stout, 6.00%

Sweet coffee and chocolate milk mix with the bitterness of hops for this tasty stout. Poured from a Nitro tap, each sip is more creamy and robust, filling your palate with wave after wave of mocha goodness. Gold medal winner at Great American Beer Festival. \$6.25

Stella Artois Cidre - Belgium

Cider, 4.5% ABV

Crisp and refreshing Belgian cider made with hand-picked apples. \$6.25

Lil' Sumpin - Lagunitas Brewing Co., Petaluma, CA

American Pale Wheat Ale, 7.5% ABV

Lil' Sumpin is brewed with three kinds of wheat and loads of hops. It is a refreshing summery beer which exudes bright apricot and grapefruit flavors. One of the most popular brews in the Lagunitas lineup, this beer really packs a punch. \$6.00

Staropramen - Staropramen Brewery, Prague, Czech Republic

Czech Pilsner, 5.0% ABV

A unique brewing process known as double decoction lays the foundation for authentic Czech taste. The brewery has been using the same yeast strain since 1871. The beer matures for weeks creating a smooth dry crisp lager which is supremely drinkable. \$5.50

Pale Ale - Sierra Nevada Brewing Co., Chico, CA

American Pale Ale, 5.6% ABV

Classic. You wouldn't be wrong to say this beer kept the American craft revolution alive. Cascade hops, introduced in America in the 1960's, contribute full aromas of pine and grapefruit. \$5.00

60 Minute IPA - Dogfish Head Craft Brewery, Milton, DE - India Pale Ale, 6.0% ABV

A nicely balanced east coast style IPA. Hops are thrown into the boil every minute of the 60 minute boiling stage, hence the name. This process reduces the overall bitterness while letting the citrus flavor of the hops shine through. \$6.50

Stowaway IPA - Baxter Brewing Co., Lewiston ME

India Pale Ale, 6.9% ABV

Stowaway has big hits of grapefruit, pine, and citrus that blend beautifully into a pleasant full-bodied crisp IPA. The beer provides a strong malt backbone and double-dry hopped process, which make it delicious to the last drop. \$6.00

Sucks - Lagunitas Brewing Co., Petaluma, CA

Imperial India Pale Ale, 7.85% ABV

This is a hop driven brew with intense mango and citrus flavors. A cereal mix of wheat, rye, oats, and barley and only 60 IBUs make this IPA ultra-smooth. \$5.50

Mountain Ale - Shed Brewery, Middlebury, VT

Old Ale, 7.0% ABV

The perfect blend of malt and hops creates this sweet and strong ale, that is the best kept secret in Vermont. \$5.50

Steel Rail - Berkshire Brewing Co., South Deerfield, MA

American Extra Pale Ale, 5.3% ABV

A rare lighter beer with enough malt and hop character to give it flavor. Biscuit, bread dough, slight citrus notes; overall, a nice mellow beer. \$5.50

Session Lager - Full Sail Brewing Co., Hood River, OR

American Helles Lager, 5.1% ABV

A pre-prohibition style lager brewed with malt and no adjuncts, its dry taste and golden color makes it a true American beer. A winner of the WBA world beer awards Helles Lager category. \$5.50

Winter Solstice - Anderson Valley Brewing Co., Boonville, CA

Winter Warmer, 6.9% ABV

Winter Solstice combines light spice, hoppy fruitiness, and rich caramel to make an exceptional winter brew. \$5.50

Cabin Fever - Berkshire Brewing Co., South Deerfield, MA

Winter Warmer, 6.3% ABV

A well-balanced beer sporting a hefty malt backbone that gives way to hints of caramel toffee sweetness. German hops add a nice spicy finish. \$12.50 (22 oz)

La Fin Du Monde - Unibroue, Chambly, QC, Canada

Triple Style Golden Ale, 9% ABV

Named after a few mistaken explorers who believed North America was the end of the world, this sweet and smooth floral bouquet with a well-hidden, yet high alcohol content, may have you believing the same. \$9.00

Perpetual - Troegs Brewing Co., Hershey, PA

Imperial Pale Ale, 7.50% ABV

The Munich Malt, used primarily for Oktoberfest beers, balances out the complex mix of six different hop strains giving *Perpetual* a strong malty taste. \$6.50

Cascadilla - Ithaca Beer Co., Ithaca, NY

Red Imperial Pale Ale, 7.0% ABV

This IPA offers intense spicy, citrusy flavors with hints of sweetness from Carmel Malt, and gets its name from copious amounts of Cascade hops used in the brewing process. \$5.50

Old Chub - Oskar Blues Brewing Co., Lyons CO

Scotch Ale, 8% ABV

Old Chub delivers huge amounts of malts which are boiled longer to caramelize. Its full-bodied mouth feel concentrates chocolate, caramel, and coffee flavors. A slight smokiness caps off this immensely praised brew. \$5.50

Old Rasputin - North Coast Brewing Co., Fort Bragg, CA

Imperial Stout, 9% ABV

For those in the know, Old Raspy is definitely at the top of their list of stouts. Big coffee and chocolate notes make this beer perfect for cold, winter months. This is an award winning beer not to be missed. \$8.50

Vanilla Porter - Breckinridge Brewery, Denver, CO

American Porter, 4.7% ABV

A light and easy beer to drink, brewed with vanilla beans from Madagascar, makes the ideal winter drink to relax from a long work day. \$5.50

Porter - Mayflower Brewing Co., Plymouth, MA

Porter, 5.2% ABV

A polished mosaic of five varieties of malted barley. The malt releases flavors of roasted coffee beans and dark chocolate, while a slight smokiness teases the tongue. \$5.50

Red Stripe - Desnoes and Geddes, Kingston, Jamaica

Lager, 4.7% ABV

A refreshing lager with lots of flavors and a light hint of sweetness. Hooray Beer! \$5.00

Banana Bread Beer - Wells and Young's Ltd., England

Fruit Beer, 5.2%

A pleasant banana aroma will entice you to sip this delectable beer. The banana oomph is not overwhelming but smooth and subdued. This is a nice dessert beer with a dry finish. \$8.00

Strawberry - Abita Brewing Co., Abita Springs, LA

Fruit Beer, 4.2% ABV

This is quite a complex beer that amalgamates wheat and pilsner malts. Real strawberry juice is added, which supplements a sweetness to this dry crisp lager. \$6.50

Original Blend Cider - Downeast Cider House,

Boston, MA - Cider, 5.1% ABV

Made from four types of locally grown apples. No preservatives or artificial flavors; sweet fruit that finishes crisp and dry. \$5.25
